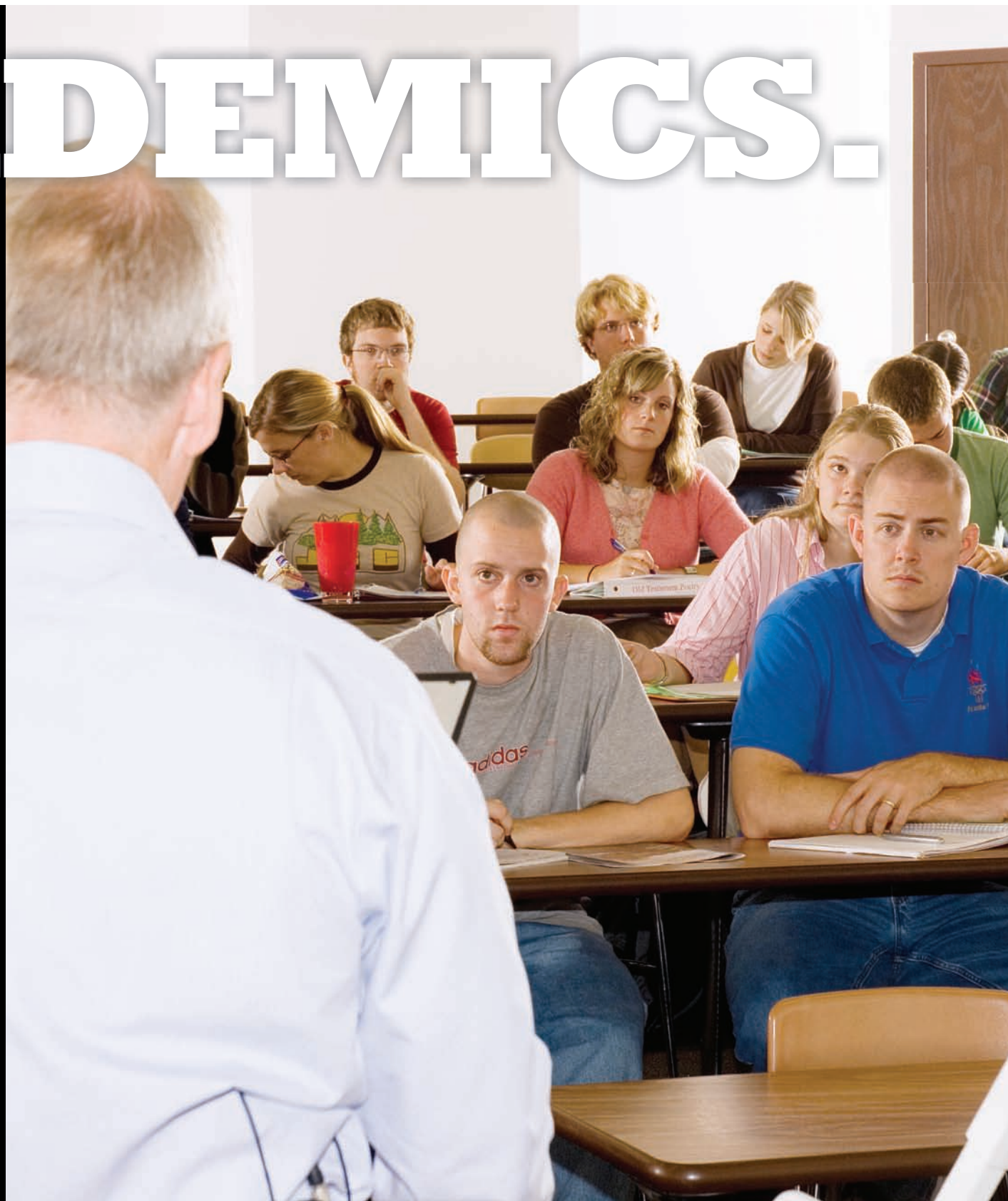

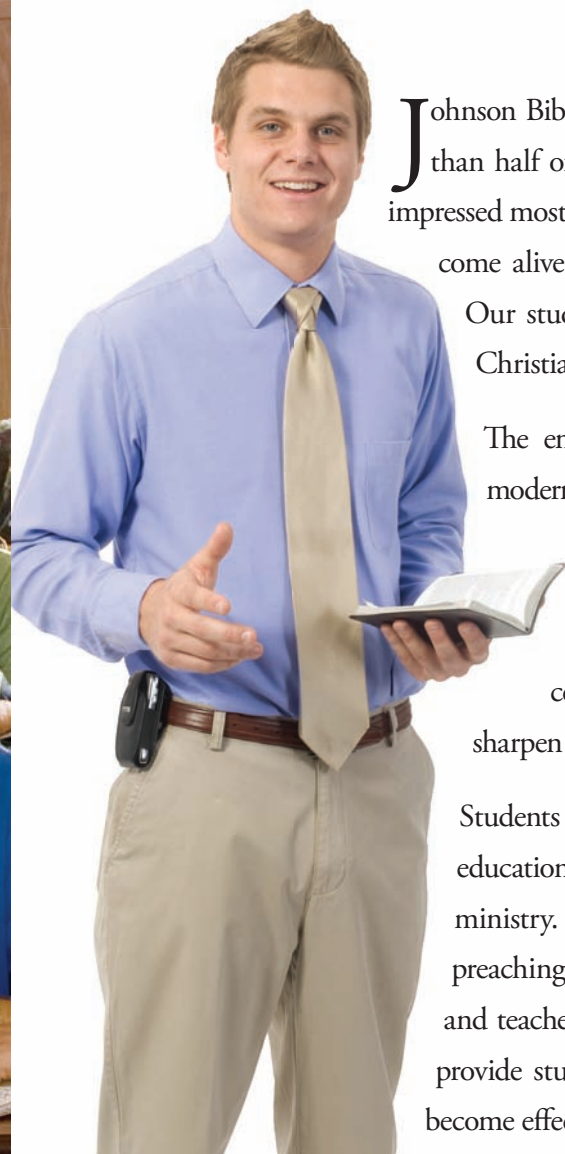

CAMPUS


One of the things that makes JBC stand out among colleges is our concern for making students feel at home. Comfortable housing options, excellent recreational facilities, and up-to-date classrooms show the College's commitment to making life at Johnson a positive experience. Our student center offers racquetball courts, a fitness center, snack bar, game tables, big screen television, and a relaxing environment for fun and friendship. A women's only workout facility is also located in Clark Hall.




UNIQUE.

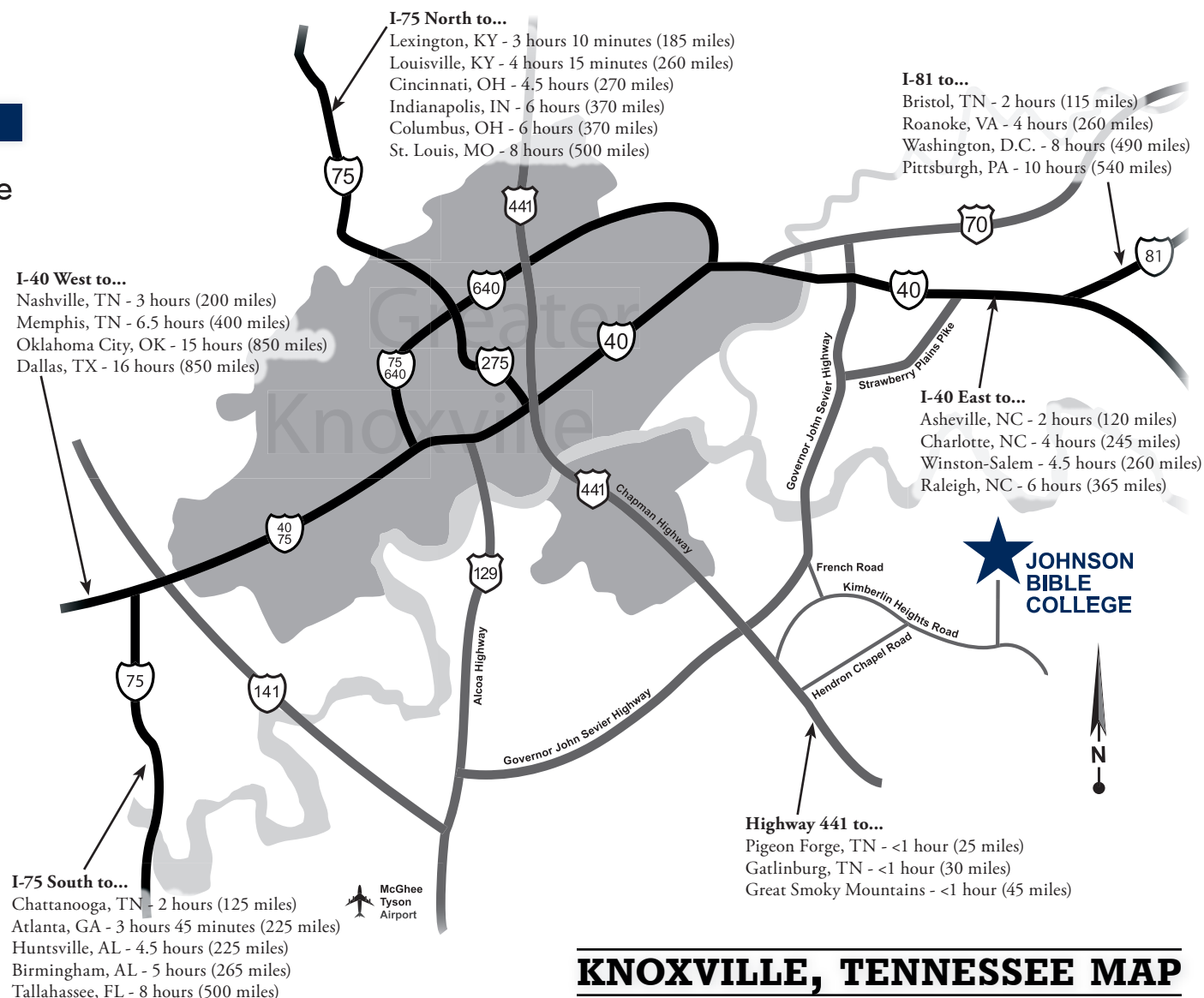
If what we've told you sounds too good to be true, come see for yourself!

GETTING HERE

From I-75 and I-40, west of Knoxville: Go to Downtown Knoxville and follow signs to Henley Street/U.S.441 South, which becomes Chapman Highway. From the river bridge downtown go past Wal-Mart to the traffic light at Hendron

Chapel Road (approx. 7 miles). Turn Left onto Hendron Chapel Road and travel 5 miles to JBC.

From I-40, east of Knoxville: Take exit 398 (Strawberry Plains Pike) and follow signs to JBC. You will make a total of 5 left turns in approximately 12 miles.
